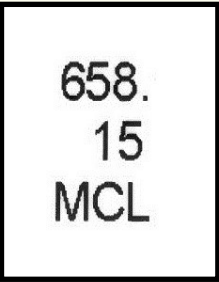

All the academic books in our libraries are arranged in Dewey number order. This means that, to make resources easier to find, every subject is given a number between 000 and 999.

For example **Management** is 658 so if you can find 658 on a spine label then the book will relate to that topic, such as **Financial Management**, which is 658.15.



The spine label also includes the first three letters of the author’s surname.

You can borrow up to **8** items at a time.

You are not charged late fines but we will chase up any *overdue items*.

Please make the most of your libraries but also be respectful of other library users by not eating in the libraries and keeping noise to a minimum.

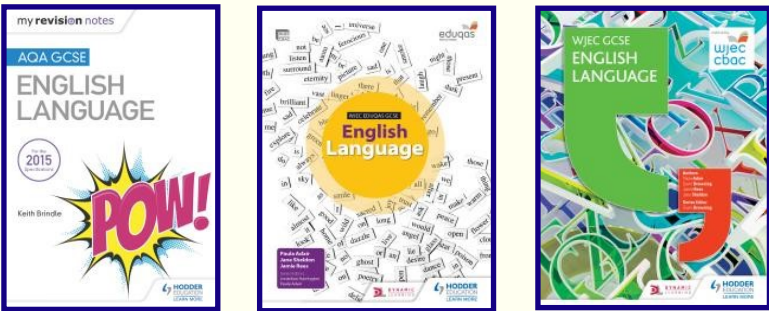
